

**Meet Conditions**

**Epsom District Swimming Club Short Course Inaugural Open Meet**

**26th & 27th June 2010**

**Facilities:** Six lane 25m pool, electronic timing with scoreboard.

**Affiliation:** Epsom District Swimming Club are affiliated to ASA South East Region.  
The meet will be held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules of Swimming.  
The meet is **licensed at level 3** and held under licence number 3SE tbc

**Age Groups:** **Age at 27th June 2010.**

Age groups 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17+ yrs.

**Entries:** **Closing date for entries is 28th May 2010.**

Entries falling within the qualifying times will be accepted on a **first come, first served basis** (when hard copy and payment received).

Epsom District SC reserve the right to close the meet or individual events within the meet earlier than the specified closing date.

All entries must include Date of Birth, and ASA Registration Number details.

Club and Individual entries will be accepted using the entry form on the website.

Epsom District SC reserves the right to reject any entry without giving a reason.

The submission of entries by entry form indicates acceptance of the Meet Rules.

Epsom District SC reserves the right to alter the entry closing deadline.

**Entry Fees:** **Entry fees are £5.00 per event.**

Cheques made payable to Epsom District SC.

The entry fee includes a levy of 25p per event payable to ASA South East.

**Events:** Events will be seeded, with heats being swum in a spearhead formation.

All events will be run on a **heat declared winner basis.**

It is the responsibility of the swimmer to report to the stewarding area in sufficient time for each event. Epsom District SC cannot be held responsible for any swimmer missing the start of their particular heat. Coaches and clubs must be responsible for ensuring that all of their swimmers are competent to perform a shallow racing dive to the standards of the ASA competitive starts award. In the event of a competitor overbalancing they should continue with a safe shallow racing dive and not fall into the water. Over the top starts may be operated at the discretion of the promoter.

**Warm up:** Swimmers and coaches must ensure that they take no action that would endanger themselves or others. Swimmers should swim in the direction indicated by the lane steward. Sprint lanes will be announced.

**Awards:** Awards will be made to the first three placed swimmers in each age group. Presentations will not be made. Awards should be collected from the awards table. Points will be awarded to the top 6 swimmers in each age group, 6 points being awarded for first place, 5 for second and so on down to one point for sixth place. The male and female swimmers who acquire the highest points in each category will be awarded the following:

Top Junior Boy 9-10yr

Top Junior Girl 9-10yr

Top Senior Boy 11+yr

Top Senior Girl 11+yr.

The top six swimmers will score points on the same basis towards the team award:

Top Visiting Club.

- Passes:** Poolside passes are available at a cost of £15.00 for 2 days or £8.00 for 1 day and will include admittance to all sessions and a programme. Each club is restricted to a maximum of 3 passes per day.
- Spectators:** Spectator entry is by programme at a cost of £3.00 per session or £5.00 per day.

- Data Protection:** Swim meet entries and results will be managed via computer. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given, as required under the Data Protection Act 1984, to the holding of personal information on a computer. Personal data, including submitted and recorded times, will be publicly available during the meet.
- Safety:** Everyone attending the event must familiarise themselves with the location of the emergency exits, which must be kept clear at all times. Everyone is asked to observe all normal precautions in the pool area and when moving around The Rainbow Leisure Centre. Swimmers must not leave poolside unless they are wearing clothes and shoes having dried themselves. Swimmers are **not** permitted to use the teaching pool for warm up or swim down or the duration of the event.
- Behaviour:** Epsom District SC Open Meet Management Staff and the Rainbow Leisure Centre Management reserve the right to remove any person from the pool area, whose behaviour is either against the pool rules or the efficient running of the meet.
- Security:** Persons are requested not to leave their belongings unattended and to ensure valuables are placed in a locked locker or kept with someone for safekeeping. Epsom District SC nor The Rainbow Leisure Centre Management will be held responsible for loss of personal property.
- Photography:** In line with the recommendations in the ASA Child Protection Policy, the Promoter of this event insists that any person wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography, including the use of mobile phones with image capturing capabilities, must register their details, in the photographic log book at the programme sales desk, prior to carrying out any such photography.
- Refunds:** Entry fees cannot be refunded, except in the event of exceptional circumstances and at the discretion of the Meet Director or Epsom District SC Open Meet Management Staff.
- Parking:** Parking is limited at the Rainbow Leisure Centre and is normally free on gala events. There are 2 further overflow car parks very close the venue. One is Hook Road just along from the Leisure Centre towards the town centre and the other is the main car park in Epsom Town Centre on Ashley Avenue behind the shops.

Any eventuality, situation or dispute not covered by the above conditions shall be determined by the Meet Director and/or Epsom District SC Open Meet Committee.
